State Legislation

The Utah State Legislature passed legislation requiring the adoption of a Water Preservation and Use Element by all municipalities (except those communities with less than 10,000 residents) (Utah Code 10-9a-403).

To fulfill this requirement and enhance their ability to address the evolving needs of their communities, Magna, Copperton, and Kearns Metro Townships are each working to develop a dedicated Water Preservation and Use element, which will be integrated as supplemental amendments to their General Plans.
