- Low Reservoir Levels

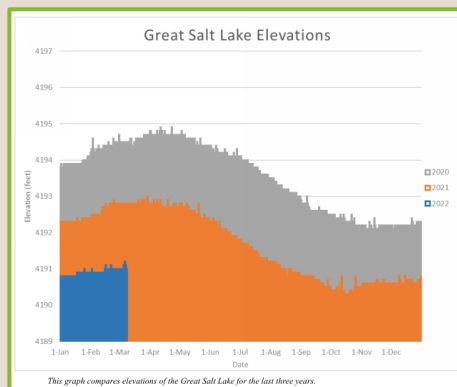
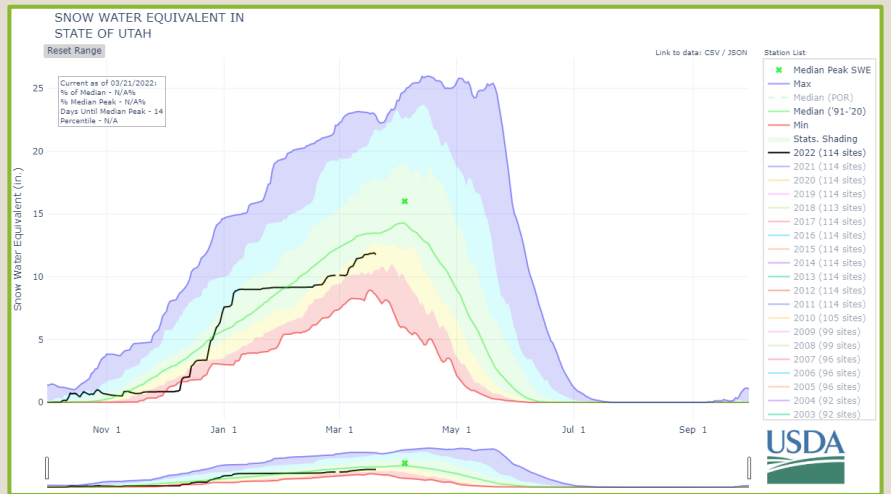
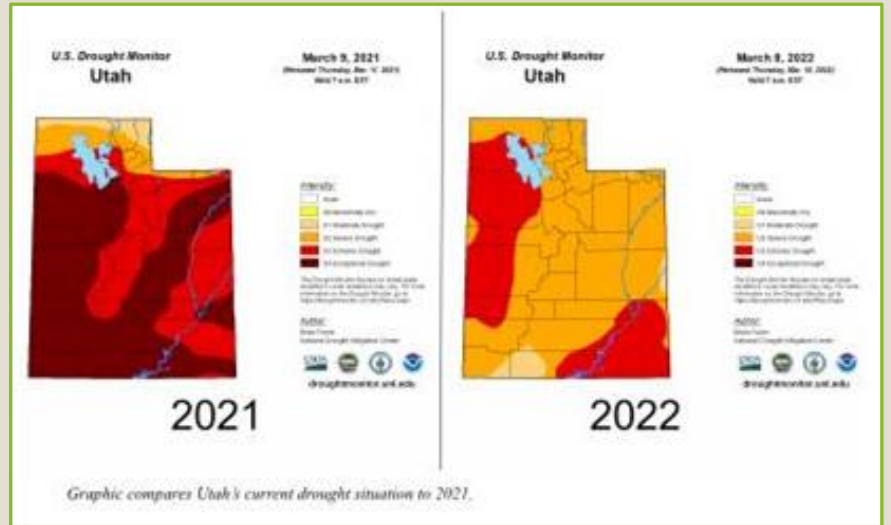
WHAT IT MEANS

LEVEL 2 MANDATORY WATER CONSERVATION

- No Outdoor Watering Between 10 am to 6 pm
- Outdoor Watering Days
 - W, F & Su for Odd Addresses
 - T, TH, Sa for Even Addresses

- 4-Step Enforcement Procedure
 - 1st Violation Warning by Mail
 - 2nd Violation Warning by Hand
 - 3rd Violation Notice & \$25 Fee
 - 4th Violation Notice & \$50 Fee

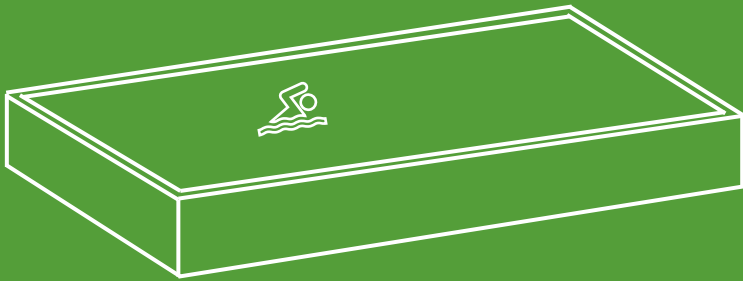
